

Mütze Timona



Materials

YARN

2 balls, (100grams) Timona Line 110 by Online-Wool

60% Merinowool superwash 40 % Microfibre (Polyacrylic)

Approx 132 yards per 50g

1 Fur PomPom

Needles

US 4, 5, circular 16" Cable needle (CB)

GAGE

20 sts and 28 rnds = 4" (10cm) in ST st.

Stitch Guide

To work the cable – place next 2 knit sts on CB, and hold in front of your work; k2 sts from left needle, k2 sts from cable needle

PATTERN

R1: *k4, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R2: *k1, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R3: *k4, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R4: *k1, p2, k1, p2, C2, p2; rep from * to end.

R5: *k4, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R6: *k1, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R7: *k4, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R8: *k1, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R9: *k4, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R10: *k1, p2, k1, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R11: *k4, p2, k4, p2; rep from * to end.

R12: *k1, p2, k1, p2, C2, p2; rep from * to end.

*Work Rnds 5 - 12 of pattern slipping the marker at the end of each rnd., until piece measures 11" (27 cm) from CO edge.

RIBBING

With smaller circular needle CO120 sts. Place marker (pm) and join for working in the rd. being careful not to twist sts.

R 1: *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep last rnd until piece measures 2.5" (6 cm)

BODY

Work rnds 1-4 once of pattern slipping the marker at the end of each rnd.,

Work rnds 5 - 12 of pattern, slipping the marker at the end of each rnd until piece measures 11.5" (27 cm) from CO edge ending with a CB rnd. (9 CB rows)

SHAPE CROWN

Every 3rd round from now on is a decease round

R1: (dec rnd) *slip next sts knit wise, k1, pull slipped stitch over sts just worked, k2tg, p1; rep from * to end.

R2: *k2, p1; rep from * to end.

R3: *k2, p1; rep from * to end.

R4: (dec rnd) *k2tg, p1: rep from * to end.

R5: *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

R6: *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

R7: (dec rnd) *k2tg; rep from * to end.

R8: knit

R9: knit

R10: (dec rnd) *k2tg; rep from * to end.

R11: knit

R12: knit

Repeat rows 10 to 12 until there are 10 stitches left on needle. Cut yarn and using a darning needle and pull yarn through the 10 remaining stitches.



Secure PomPom from the inside with a safety pin. That way you can remove the pompom when washing the Muetze. If you don't have a fur pompom you can make a yarn pompom and sew it securely onto the Muetze. In that case you will need one extra ball of yarn.
